



Immunization Clinics

Public Health Immunization Clinics provide immunizations to residents who do not have health insurance coverage for immunizations. These clinics do not replace well-child checkups or annual exams by healthcare providers.

Scott County Public Health participates in Minnesota Vaccines for Children (MnVFC), a program that provides low-cost vaccines for infants age six weeks and older and children through age 18 who do not have insurance that covers immunizations. Scott County Public Health also provides immunizations at reduced cost for adults.

Appointments: Call the Scott County Public Health Office to make your appointment at 952-496-8552.

Records: Bring an up-to-date record of all past immunizations.

Permission Forms: Shots cannot be given to children under age 18 unless parents/guardians have signed a permission form for the child to receive shots.

Payments: A \$10 donation per vaccine (cash or check only) is appreciated, but is not required, from those who qualify for MnVFC. Individuals may pay for vaccines if they are not eligible for the MnVFC program. Scott County Public Health does not bill commercial insurance.

Interpreter Services: Upon request, a telephone interpreter will be used. Vaccine information is available in most languages.

Vaccines Provided under the MnVFC Program:

Children

- All required vaccines for day care, Headstart, and school (elementary through high school).
- Plus recommended vaccines including Hepatitis A, Human Papillomavirus (HPV), Meningococcal, and Influenza.

Adults

- Scott County Public Health is currently offering tetanus (Td/Tdap), pneumonia, HPV (Gardasil), MMR (measles, mumps, rubella), Hepatitis A, Hepatitis B, chickenpox, and influenza vaccinations to eligible adults.
- Any adult 19 years or older, who is underinsured or uninsured, can receive the above immunizations.
