Scott County Ordinance 22, Management of the Public Right-of-Way, Section 119: The excavation, backfilling, patching and restoration, and all other work performed in the right-of-way shall be done in conformance with Minnesota Rules 7819.1100, 7819.5000 and 7819.5100 and shall conform to MnDOT standard specifications and other applicable local requirements, in so far as they are not inconsistent with the Minn. Stat. § 237.162 and 237.163.

SPECIAL PROVISIONS: _____

It is expressly understood that this permit is conditioned upon replacement or restoration of the county road to its original or satisfactory condition. It is further understood that this permit is issued subject to the applicant's compliance with the rules and regulations of the local, city, township authorities and any other affected governmental agencies.

PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

(Note: Allow up to 2 weeks for processing. An incomplete application will delay processing.)

1. Print, in ink only, or type the application. Be sure to sign both this instruction sheet and the application form at the bottom. Submit the original forms only. Faxed copies will not be accepted.
2. Complete each item on the application. If an item does not apply, print "N.A." in the blank.
3. No foreign material such as dirt, gravel, or bituminous material shall be left or deposited on the roadway during the work. If material is tracked onto the roadway, it must be removed immediately.
4. Any debris generated due to the work must be removed from the County right-of-way within 24 hours.
5. Prior to construction, the permittee shall notify the County Inspector at 952-496-8487. After completion, the permittee shall notify the County Inspector for final inspection by the County Highway Department.
6. No changes or alterations may be made at any time without written permission from the County Highway Department.
7. For the safety of the traveling public, and for the safety of those working in the right-of-way, the proper signage or barricades must be placed in accordance with the standards of the County Highway Department and the Minnesota Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Device's "Temporary Traffic Control Zone Layouts Field Manual".
8. For rural accesses, 6:1 side slopes are required within the County right-of-way.
9. For new residential accesses, swing-away mailboxes are required (see attachment to residential access permits).
10. Disturbed areas will need to be addressed (i.e. seeded, mulched and anchored or sod) with the proper erosion control, including temporary erosion control as needed, within 7 days and maintained until the new turf is established. All work shall be in compliance with local, state and federal regulations.
11. In the event that the construction has not been completed within one year of the permit approval date, this permit becomes null and void.
12. It is the responsibility of the contractor to notify Gopher State One Call for utility locations for any work being performed within the County right-of-way, and to obtain all other necessary permits.
13. No work under this application is to begin until the application is approved, and the permit issued, unless permission has been granted by the County Engineer or his/her designee.
14. Any party working within the County right-of-way under this permit shall have a copy of the approved permit on site. Any party working in the County right-of-way without County approval or without a copy of the approved permit may be required to vacate the right-of-way immediately.
15. All Right of Way Permits are subject to double fees for unauthorized work.

I/We agree to all of the above requirements. All work performed will be done to the satisfaction of the Scott County Highway Department.

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COMMERCIAL ACCESS APPLICATION CHECKLIST

- Signed Full Plan Set.** Showing all inplace utilities and structures.
- Signage & Striping Plan Sheet Stating Epoxy Paint-** The following information needs to be included on the Signage & Striping Plan Set:

The road surface shall be cleaned at the direction of the Scott County Highway Engineer just prior to application. Pavement cleaning shall consist of at least brushing with a rotary broom (non-metallic) or as recommended by the material manufacturer and acceptable to the Scott County Highway Engineer. The Epoxy marking application shall immediately follow the pavement cleaning. An Epoxy Resin Line 4 inches wide and 15 mil thickness (wet), requires an application rate of (1) gal of components for 320 ft of line (glass beads shall be applied at a pound per gallon rate sufficient to achieve an immediate no-track system) and striping operations shall be conducted only when the road pavement surface temperatures are 50 F or greater. Permanent pavement markings shall not be placed over any temporary or permanent markings. It will be the responsibility of the Developer/Contractor to place control points for pavement markings to be inspected and approved by Scott County Highway Engineer prior to application.
- Removal/Replacement Plan Sheet.**
- Erosion Control Plan Sheet** – Showing all B.M.P.'s. Also show what is to be seed or sod and what is to be mulched & tugged or blanketed.
- Pavement Section w/Mix Designs** - Approved Sub Base, Class 5 Base, Bituminous Base Course, Tack Coat, Bituminous Binder Course, Tack Coat, Bituminous Wear Course. Scott County will determine required G.E. and advise on thicknesses & mix designation.
- Cross Sections Every 50' & At Every Approach or Culvert-** Showing 4:1 Inslopes Inside Grading Limits at a scale of 1"=10' Vertical & Horizontal.
- Bypass/RTL or LTL Detail with Milling/Sawcut Detail Shown On Plan**
These plans can be obtained from the Scott County Highway Department.
- Easements For Road Improvements Need To Be Recorded Prior To Application Approval.**
- Certified Passing Density Tests Will Be Required-** The following information needs to be shown on plan set:

Contractor must provide certified documentation of passing density in compliance with MnDOT specifications to the Scott County Highway Engineer prior to commencing with the next phase of construction.
- Rock (or Other Approved Material) Construction Entrance and Sweeping Will Be Required –**
Must be shown on plan set & installed prior to beginning construction.
