Cedar Lake Farm Regional Park
2012 Group Camp Guidelines

Cedar Lake Regional Park Located in Scott County, this 250 acre park offers a spectacular setting for group events such as family picnics, business retreats, outdoor weddings/receptions, and recreational/educational activities. Enjoy the beautiful setting on the south shore of Cedar Lake near New Prague with more than 20 acres of picnic and recreational area and 1,000 feet of shoreline for waterfront activities.

General Park Hours 9 am – sunset, daily (typically Mid May - Mid September)

Cedarview Group Camp Capacity of 50 people; tent camping only; 5 night maximum; all campers must be on-site by dusk when the park closes to the general public; no in/out unless an emergency. For more information please contact the on-site caretakers or call 763-694-7777.

Rental Fees

Reservation and Payment At time of reservation, payment is due in full. Payment can be made by MasterCard, Visa, American Express or Discover. Payment may be made by cash or check if received at time of reservation.

Lakeside Shelter Cancellation Policy

- If a cancellation is made *90 days prior* to the use date, 100% of the fee will be refunded.
- If a cancellation is made *60 days prior* to the use date, 50% of the fee will be refunded.
- All cancellations *after 60 days* are non-refundable.
- No refunds are given due to weather conditions unless the park or facility is officially closed due to severe, life-threatening weather.

Permit/Confirmation entitles your group to exclusive use of the area during the time indicated on the permit. Please make sure you have your permit with you when arriving at the park. If you have further questions please call 763.694.7777.

Firewood Two 12"x20"x12" compartments of firewood are provided per night at each group camp and should be on-site at the time of arrival. Additional firewood is also available for purchase from the caretakers during regular operating hours.

Only approved firewood can be used at Cedar Lake Farm. Firewood may be purchased from an approved DNR firewood vendor within 100 miles of the park. A receipt must accompany firewood to verify the purchase location. This policy was implemented to help prevent the spread of invasive pests such as the Emerald Ash borer.

Alcohol Policy Beer, wine, ciders, hard lemonades, and other malt based, single-serving beverages are permitted in glass bottles or cans only. Alcoholic beverages served in kegs, barrels, boxed wine, or bulk containers are prohibited, unless authorized by special use permit. To obtain a special use permit please contact one of the Park District Approved Caterers.

No alcohol will be consumed on Park premises by any person under the legal age. Valid identification may be requested of any person(s) who appear to be under age at any time during your event. All guests must have a valid ID if they plan to consume alcoholic beverages.

Smoking It shall be unlawful for any person to smoke or use tobacco products in or within 25 feet of any entrance to any indoor area or in the designated perimeter of any creative play area, beach, swim pond, or water play area.

Music/Amplification Live bands and DJs are not allowed at the group campsites.

Pets in the Park Pets are NOT allowed at Cedar Lake Farm Regional Park

Signs and Banners Temporary signs on independent laths may be located within the park. Banners or signs may not be tied, taped, or otherwise affixed to or across trees, signs or other post-type structures. All signs and banners must be removed at the end of your stay.

Parking Information Parking is free for personal/family vehicles in all Three Rivers Parks.

Site Clean-up and Recycling

- Normal site maintenance is included in your reservation fee. If your group causes extraordinary maintenance service, your group will be charged at an hourly rate to cover labor costs. Your group is responsible to generally pick up the site at the conclusion of your event.
- Damage done to your site will result in your group being assessed fees to cover the cost of the damages and labor for repairs. Please be sure your group members are aware of this policy.
- Clean up any items such as balloons, balloon fragments, or eggs that are used for games and decoration. These are dangerous to wildlife.
- Please recycle. Each group-camp area has recycling receptacles for beverage cans and plastic bottles.

Park Amenities

Swimming Beach is open daily, from mid-May – mid-September.

Beach hours: 9 a.m. - sunset, Swimming is permitted in designated swimming area within the marked swim buoy. No lifeguard on duty. Please no glass in the beach area

Boat Access a portion of the park is designated for shore landing. A public boat launch is available on the south east corner of the lake.

Fishing from shore is permitted, except in designated swimming area.

Horseshoe/Pit are available on a first come first serve basis. Equipment is available through the caretaker.

Softball Field a large open space is available for a game of softball.

Grilling is permitted. Coals must be disposed of in designated coal barrel. Limited number of public grills available.
