Runners-up included **Sofia Fritzke, age 10, Jordan Elementary (Jordan)**; and **Kendra Oliphant, age 8, Jordan Elementary (Jordan)**. Contestants were asked to submit original artwork with a winter-themed picture incorporating the Scott County Sheriff's Office in some way.

The winner, Aubrie Sutherland, will have her design featured on the front cover of the official Scott County Sheriff's Office 2017 Season's Greetings cards. She will also receive a ride in a Sheriff's Patrol Car, breakfast or lunch with Sheriff Hennen, and 10 copies of the printed greeting card. The winner and runners-up will all receive recognition on the Scott County Sheriff's Office social media pages, Scott County Sheriff's Office travel mugs, Certificates of Excellence, and a commemorative Sheriff's Office "Challenge Coin."
