



Scott County Public Health Clinics



Scott County Public Health offers several clinics for Scott County residents who are uninsured or under-insured:



The Mobile Health Clinic in partnership with the Statewide Health Improvement Partnership provides free care for short term illness, ongoing health problems, and health screenings. Clinic services are free for all residents.



The Immunization Clinic gives immunizations to Scott County residents age 6 weeks through adulthood. The clinic is generally open two Monday's per month from 2:00-5:00 pm. The clinic is located at the Workforce Center, 792 Canterbury Road, Suite 231. Appointments can be made by calling 952-496-8555. A \$10 donation per vaccine is appreciated, but not required.



Nurse Walk-in Clinic offers care for residents who need help with health issues, such as immunizations, blood pressure checks, glucose monitoring, and general health questions. The Walk-In Clinic also provides Tuberculosis skin tests (Mantoux), which are given on Tuesday and read on Thursday. There is a \$15 fee for the Mantoux testing. The Walk-In Clinic is open Tuesday and Thursday mornings 8:30-10:30 am at the Workforce Center, 792 Canterbury Road, Suite 231 in Shakopee.
